

# RIBBON POINSETTIAS

## MATERIALS FOR ONE FLOWER:

(Ribbon width can be from 1 3/4" to 2 1/2". We are using 2 1/2" ribbon.)

1 yard GREEN wire- edged ribbon  
1 1/4 yards RED wire- edged ribbon  
Berry or floral pick for center  
1 yard of 26 gauge green wire  
Clip clothespins

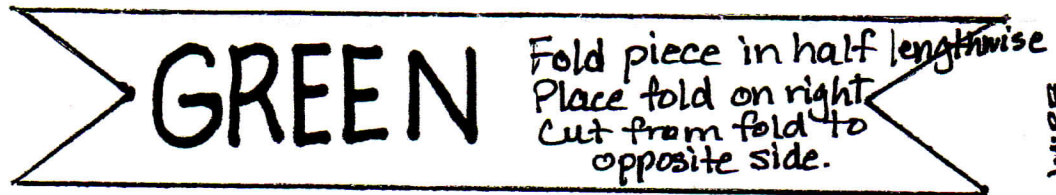
## CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

Cut **FOUR 9"** inch pieces of **GREEN** ribbon for leaves. (Fold into quarters + cut)

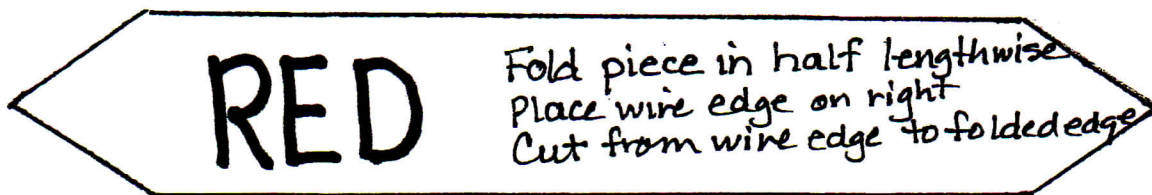
Cut **THREE 8"** pieces of **RED** for petals.

Cut **THREE 7"** pieces of **RED** for petals.

CUT BOTH ENDS OF THE **GREEN** RIBBON IN A "V" SHAPE



CUT BOTH ENDS OF THE **RED** RIBBON IN POINTS.



## ASSEMBLY:

1. Gather or pleat the 4 green leaves in the center and wire together. Use the clothespin to hold them while you are working the others.
2. Gather the 8 inch pieces of red and add them on top of the green and wire together.
3. Gather the 7 inch pieces of red and add them on top of the 8 inch red and wire together. You can place this last layer perpendicular to the others and wire together.
4. Spread out the leaves and petals. Add the pick on the top and wire it on. Fiddle with the petals until you like the way it looks!!
